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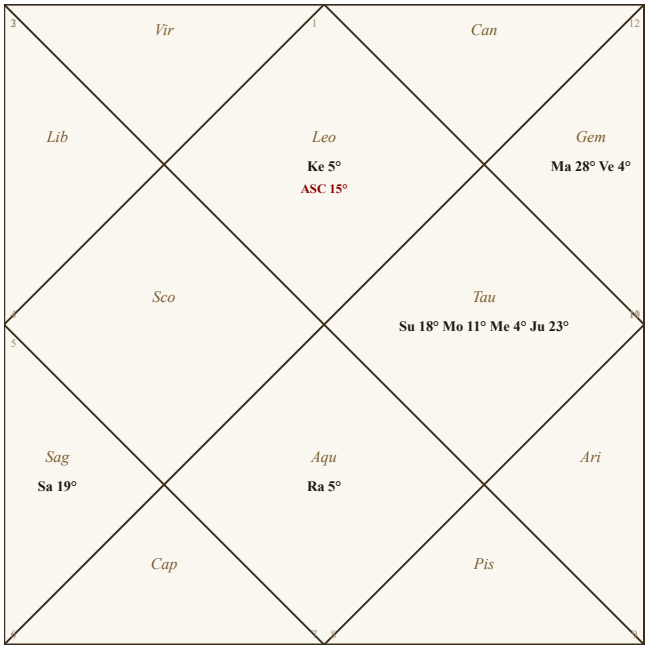

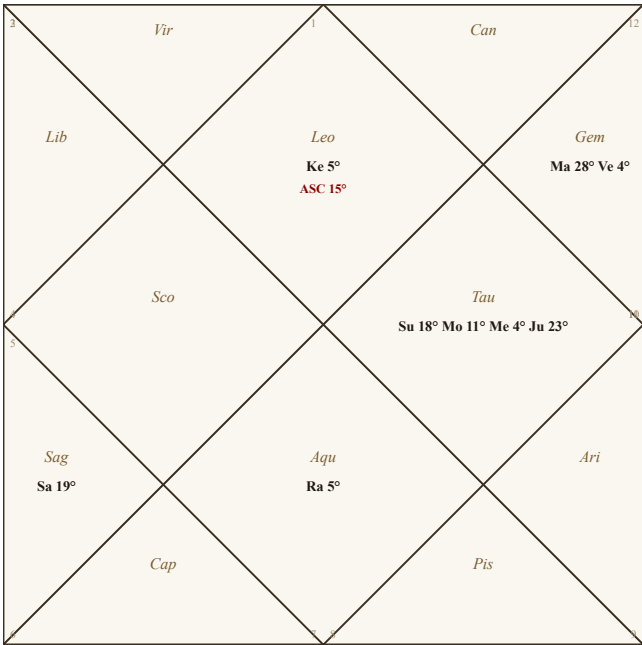

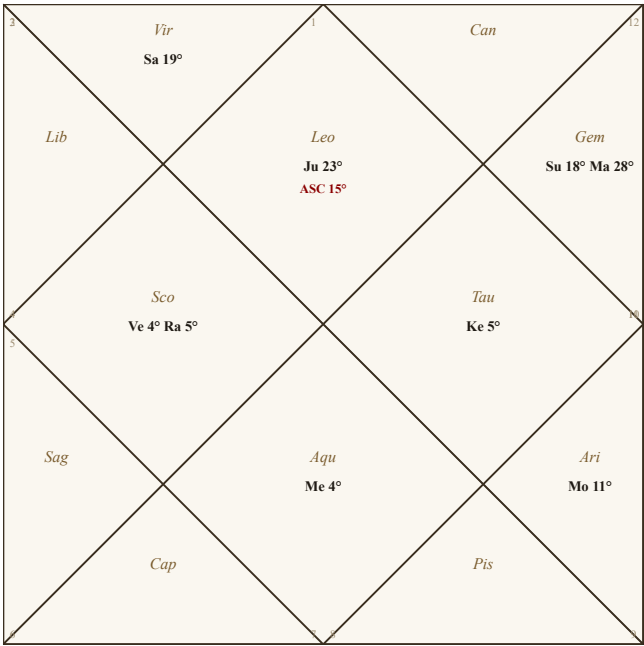

⊕ = own-house aspect (planet aspecting a house it owns). Per classical rule, this aspect is **always protective, never malefic**, regardless of the planet's natural nature. Ownership bond overrides malefic classification.

JUPITER MAHADASHA — OVERALL THEME

The 16-year Guru Mahadasha is, classically, the most auspicious of the dasha periods for most natives. It expands wisdom, dharmic conduct, fortune, children, husband (in a woman's chart), wealth, and recognition by the wise. Well-placed Jupiter (own/exalted, in kendra/trikona, unafflicted) brings birth of children, religious pilgrimage, scholarly achievement, marriage (if pending), wealth growth, and rise in social esteem. Afflicted Jupiter (debilitated, in dushtana houses, conjunct Rahu — Guru Chandala — or with Saturn-Mars combination) yields loss of confidence in matters of dharma, troubles with children or guru figures, and over-expansion leading to obesity or hubris. The period favours teaching, philosophical study, and expansion of family. It rewards generosity and ethical conduct visibly. Long enough to fundamentally redirect a life path.

CHART-SPECIFIC READING

Jupiter rules dushtana houses [WARNING]

Jupiter rules house(s) 8 (6=enemies/illness/debt, 8=longevity/sudden change, 12=loss/expenditure). Dushtana lord during own dasha can bring stress in those domains unless redeemed by exaltation, own sign, or strong placement. Currently in Taurus (Other) — without strong dignity, the difficulty stands.

Saturn is a Maraka in this chart [WARNING]

Saturn rules the 7th (yuvati/partnership) house. Lords of these houses act as marakas (death-inflicting) in classical jyotish, particularly powerful when sitting in 2nd or 7th itself, or aspecting them. Currently placed in Bhava 5, the maraka effect is present but the placement softens it somewhat.

Saturn rules dushtana houses [WARNING]

Saturn rules house(s) 6 (6=enemies/illness/debt, 8=longevity/sudden change, 12=loss/expenditure). Dushtana lord during own dasha can bring stress in those domains unless redeemed by exaltation, own sign, or strong placement. Currently in Sagittarius (Other) — without strong dignity, the difficulty stands.

JUPITER / SATURN — COMBO EFFECTS

MIXED — NEUTRAL RELATION

Jupiter and Saturn are neutral to each other. Results are mixed and depend primarily on the specific houses each planet rules and occupies in your chart. Examine both planets' dignities and house lordships for the actual weight of the period.

GEMSTONE RECOMMENDATION (LAGNA-BASED, NOT DASHA-BASED)

FOR LEO ASCENDANT

Primary: Ruby (Sun - lagnesh)

Secondary (with caution): Coral (Mars - 4L+9L yogakaraka); Yellow Sapphire (Jupiter - 5L+8L)

Avoid: Blue Sapphire (Saturn = 6L+7L marak); Diamond (Venus = 3L+10L); Emerald (Mercury = 2L+11L)

Gemstone recommendations are determined by the ascendant lord's strength and the lagna chart's house lordships, not by current dasha. Always confirm with a qualified astrologer before wearing.

Ruchaka Yoga — Mars *[ABSENT]*

Mars is in Gemini — not own/exalted. Ruchaka yoga conditions not met.

Bhadra Yoga — Mercury *[ABSENT]*

Mercury is in Taurus — not own/exalted. Bhadra yoga conditions not met.

Hamsa Yoga — Jupiter *[ABSENT]*

Jupiter is in Taurus — not own/exalted. Hamsa yoga conditions not met.

Malavya Yoga — Venus *[ABSENT]*

Venus is in Gemini — not own/exalted. Malavya yoga conditions not met.

Sasa Yoga — Saturn *[ABSENT]*

Saturn is in Sagittarius — not own/exalted. Sasa yoga conditions not met.

MANGAL DOSHA

Non-Mangalic — Mars in Bhava 11

Mars is in Bhava 11 (Gemini 28.17°). Mangal Dosha requires Mars in bhavas 1, 2, 4, 7, 8, or 12.

Honourable, virtuous, all-pleasures, wealthy. Some classical authors note delays in marriage and progeny challenges.

Obstacles in career, lack of paternal happiness. One school says parents die in native's boyhood.

Gains through luck; income increases.

PLANET IN HOUSE — EFFECTS (BHRIGU SUTRAM)

SUN IN BHAVA 10 (TAURUS 19.0°)

Sun in the tenth grants distinguished educational achievement by the 18th year. With three planet aspects, governmental favour and pious deeds; exaltation in 10th forms a strong Dhana yoga (e.g., Cancer ascendant). In Leo (own sign), 10th-lord-in-10th creates a powerful Rajayoga. With malefic association, career obstructs and conduct may become immoral.

Educational distinction by 18; capable and famous.

With strong 10th lord, the native is highly virtuous. With malefic aspect, an illicit affair with a widow in the 27th year is flagged, with reputational damage, sinful tendencies, and obstacles in all spheres.

High educational attainment; pious, kind; widow-affair at 27 if afflicted.

With two benefics, rulership of a great kingdom and prosperous brothers. In own sign or exalted Capricorn (Pisces ascendant), a powerful Dhana yoga emerges.

MERCURY IN BHAVA 10 (TAURUS 4.8°)

Mercury in the tenth brings success through virtuous deeds, patience, widespread reputation, greatness of thought. The 28th year flags eye troubles. In own sign or exalted or with Jupiter: many religious rites. In enemy sign or with malefic: stupidity, sinful deeds, bad conduct. In own sign Gemini in 10th, lagna and 10th lord both in 10th.

Success through virtue; eye troubles at 28.

SATURN IN BHAVA 5 (SAGITTARIUS 19.0°)

Saturn in the fifth: childless, very poor, inferior trades, adopted daughter. In own sign: daughters. With Jupiter aspect: two wives, first issueless, second with daughters. Strong Saturn: many affairs. For Aries, Taurus, Libra ascendants: powerful Dhana yoga.

Childless and poor; daughters if own sign; affairs.

Aspects received (Graha Drishti):

- Mars — malefic, 7th (full) from H11: 7th drishti acts like a conjunction per Bhrigu — difficult sutras prominent

- Ketu — malefic, 5th (special) from H1: special aspect adds pressure — cross-reference challenging sutras

RAHU IN BHAVA 7 (AQUARIUS 6.0°)

Rahu in the seventh: two wives, first dies, second has tumour. With malefic: 'Ganda-mala' disease. With benefic: only one wife, no disease.

Two wives; first dies; second has tumour; Ganda-mala if malefic.

Aspects received (Graha Drishti):

Saturn — protective (own-house aspect), 3th (special) from H5: Saturn aspects ITS OWN house — classical rule: aspect on own house is NEVER malefic regardless of planet's nature. Protective, not destructive.

Ketu — malefic, 7th (full) from H1: 7th drishti acts like a conjunction per Bhrgu — difficult sutras prominent

Net: mixed — balance of factors; dasha/transit timing is key.

KETU IN BHAVA 1 (LEO 6.0°)

Rahu (or Ketu) in the first: wife may give birth to a stillborn child. In Aries, Taurus, or Cancer: kind-hearted, enjoyment-loving. With malefic aspect: face-marks (possibly from disease like smallpox in classical era).

Wife's stillborn; marks on face; kindhearted in Aries/Taurus/Cancer.
